Jack-High Straight Flush

APALAZZOGALLERY is delighted to announce the first solo show in Italy of Luc Ming Yan (Dijon, 1994) in the gallery.

The main interest of the artist, who defines himself as a colourist, is indeed his research into colour.

This research is developed in various directions, using a range of different formats and working from abstraction to figuration to imagination, always through groups of works, some of which are developed simultaneously.

Luc Ming Yan's painting works are endowed with a powerful gestural energy and denote a high level of executive concentration.

The enigmatic language draws on themes from tradition, from comics, cartoons, from the observation of the image and from pure imagination, without imposing limits or frameworks.

The show features 27 works from the most recent production of the young artist, based in Dijon.

The title of this solo show borrows from an expression used in poker, and refers to a very lucky hand of cards, meaning that it is unnecessary to bluff. The game of poker calls for choices, decisions, luck and misfortune. Just like in poker, also in painting there is an element of chance, the *suite coloreé* which, according to the artist, refers to the logic of the colour scale.
